Description of Incident
At approximately 7:30PM Antonio Coderro left the property. While driving down Pattison Avenue he witnessed two teenaged boys driving what he noticed to be one of the golf carts belonging to the property. He drove up to the golf cart and told boys he knew where they lived and they were going to be in trouble. One of the boys said they would take it back. Antonio drove behind them in his car to make sure they return the cart. Antonio called the police, but the boys ran off before the police arrived.
Corrective action taken at the time of the incident
A police report was filed. Antonio secured the golf cart before leaving the property. I contacted Kim with Cardinal Security as there was no guard at the booth at 7:30PM when Antonio left the property , no guard at the booth when he returned with the golf cart and still no guard when he left again at 8:20PM. The maintenance team will be reminded again to lock the golf carts.
