Description of Incident
On Tuesday March 23rd, Cornell was concierge on duty. At 2am the police arrived and said they received a call from apt 1101. The police took the elevator to apt 1101. Shortly after the fire and rescue team arrived. 10-15 minutes later, fire and rescue brought the resident from apt 1101 down on a gurney. Lloyd was bleeding and the blood was in the elevator on the walls and floor. Fire and Rescue said they were taking Lloyd to Einstein Hospital. 30 minutes later the police brought Lloyd's girlfriend downstairs and took her in their police car. Cleantech was called to clean the elevator and the hallway floors, walls. I spoke to Lloyd today. He said his girlfriend has dementia and it has progressed. She will not be back to the Yorkhouse; she is a permanent resident at a nursing home now.

We checked back with Lloyd to make sure he is feeling well.
