We contacted 911- Dr. Miller woke and we provided him with water. I asked him if he was ill or positive for Covid-19 he relayed that he was not positive or I??.I, he said he had traveled from North Carolina and was moving his belongings and was tired and dehydrated. Dr Miller sat on the floor for awhile and then went to his apartment. The ambulance arrived and I took them to Dr. Millers apartment they questioned the Dr but did not take him to the hospital. They let me know he seemed ok and left.

Corrective action taken at the time of the incident
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911 was contacted, we provided water and asked Dr. Miller if there was anything we could do to assist him. He did not want to go to the hospital and said he just need to test for awhile.

What we have done related to Customer Service and helping the resident, if anything?
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We Contacted Dr. Miller after the ambulance left and asked if he was ok, we asked if he had been exposed or if he tested positive for Covid, he said he had not and that he was feeling better. We welcomed him and let him know to give us a call if he needed anything.
