After reviewing the cameras, I could see that a young man was seen taking a small table top grill and dumping contents into the recycling dumpster, which then started to smoke minutes later. Same man came back and tried to pour water on the debris. Fire started and he then closed lids to the dumpster trying to put the fire out. Fire dept came and put out fire.

Corrective action taken at the time of the incident

Mascaro was notified as dumpster lids are now melted.

What we have done related to Customer Service and helping the resident, if anything?

It was determined that the person who dumped the ashes lives in B407. Will be contacting them about this incident and removing the grill. He was notified that if there are costs associated with the damage to the dumpster, then he will be charged.
