Description of Incident

On Sunday 7/7/24 at around 5am Dawn Buck, Community Director, received a call from monitoring company Emergency Response for the office alarm going off. Emergency Response dispatched police and Dawn called David Williams, on call maintenance, to check the office. When they arrived they did not find anyone in the office and no sign of anything out of place. Upon reviewing the cameras, it was determined that at 4:51 am tall thin person tried to enter the A bldg lobby and when they could not, they stole a package from above mail area. They then backed their car in front of leasing office and tried windows. They were able to enter the office through the rear window. They climbed in window and set off alarm and then climbed out and fled.

Corrective action taken at the time of the incident

Emergency Response called police and David Williams checked to make sure office was locked and secure

Ensured that all office windows are locked and secure. We temporarily increased patrol to 7 days/week for the next 2 weeks.
