Description of Incident

On Monday, July 17th, I was told that a resident's aide was stuck in an elevator on Saturday evening. No one knew who the aide was. The staff began asking residents for the woman's name so we could call and check on her and determine facts regarding the incident. On Tuesday evening, July 18th, the evening concierge identified the aide and brought her back to my office. On Saturday, July 15, 2023 at 6:59pm, Kera William, a resident aide used elevator #9. Kera said the elevator was stuck on the 4th floor. Kera used the elevator phone to call for help. The elevator phone calls the front desk. There was no answer. Kera said she tried a couple of times, for approximately 20 minutes and never received an answer. Kera said she started making noise and yelling for help. Someone answered her and said they were going for help. The front desk concierge arrived. He told Kera that he could not call 911 for help for her. Kera called 911 from her cell phone. The police arrived and freed Kera from the elevator cab.

There were no employees present at the time.
