### **Description of Incident**

At approximately 6:35 p.m., a young boy appeared to be struggling in the pool. A woman nearby attempted to alert staff by shouting for help, but there was no immediate response from the lifeguard on duty. The child's father, hearing the woman's call, quickly intervened and removed his son from the water. The lifeguard did not approach the child or guardian afterward, nor did they appear to assess the situation. Approximately 20 minutes later, the lifeguard walked over to the pool area briefly before returning to their seat. A similar check was conducted on the opposite side of the pool about five minutes later.

### Corrective action taken at the time of the incident

Parent removed child from the water, Parent spoke with child about pool safety, No action observed from lifeguard regarding the incident

# What we have done related to Customer Service and helping the resident, if anything?

No staff member was approached for assistance, and no formal report or complaint was made by the individuals involved. As of this writing, the child and guardian remain unidentified. We don't know if the boy is a resident or a guest. Both Frank and I looked at the camera footage and did not see any boy who need assistance in the pool. At that time there were appox 18 - 20 people at the pool area.
