Description of Incident

Spalding from Tower 1 upper level overhang and eyebrow areas dropped down to patio below. Craig Lashely of 126-1 found loose piece of concrete on his patio.

Corrective action taken at the time of the incident

Josh and maintenance tech checked unit above. Josh and I inspected the area with Brian and had area taped off with caution tape. surrounding units which looked like there was any possibility of having similar situation taped over doors and patio areas for caution. Frank Lindy, Josh, and I met Joe Phillips, Joseph B. Callaghan structural engineer, 8AM 8/27.

What we have done related to Customer Service and helping the resident, if anything?

Met with Craig at the time of report and ensured we will make sure he is safe. explained closing off sliding doors and patio, until further notice. Told him first thing in morning engineer will inspect. Resident suffers from PTSD, he was not feeling safe in unit and could not handle looking out at caution tape. Travis worked with Craig to find a suitable unit to transfer to, as resident doesn't want to be on ground level anymore.
