From what I could see from the security video, it looks like the residents kid from E802, came down to Kidville and approached two other kids . The kid from E802 slapped a cell phone out of another kids hand (wearing a yellow hoodie). The kid with the yellow hoodie, looks as though to call his older brother, who then came down to Kidville. Both kids had words and began fighting, where as the older brother of the kid in the yellow hoodie threw the first punch. The fight lasted a couple minutes, whereas the kid from E802 received a punch to the face/eye and the fight ended.
Corrective action taken at the time of the incident
Spoke with resident Raina Ibrahim, who resides in E802, and she is the mother of the kid who was punched in the face. I asked her to provide our office with a copy of the police report.
What we have done related to Customer Service and helping the resident, if anything?
Posting signs at Kidville that No One is Permitted without Supervision. Jeremy is working on a more permanent sign. Brian K. is going to contact ESS to have the door locked with key fob entry Also resident communication will be sent to the community.
