I am mediately suggested to the woman that she go to the hospital and that I call 911. At first she refused, but later agreed, so I contacted 911. Due to traffic in the parking lot the woman insisted on getting up, so I helped her move to the sidewalk curb. First Jenkintown police arrived and then Second Alarmer's ambulance. The woman's name is Jennifer Ryan (spelling of last name may not be accurate). The ambulance transported her to Abington Hospital.
