Description of Incident

Fire occurred under the kitchen sink base cabinet, at the outlets. The resident had an 3-prong adapter plugged into the dishwasher side outlet. The adapter arced and caused a minor electrical fire. No real fire, just the arching in the outlet that caused damage to the outlet cover, black smoke and soot.

Corrective action taken at the time of the incident

Leno Quattlebaum, maintenance tech, was on-call and went to apartment S607 to address the issue. Kenny Poteat wasn't informed until Thursday, 11/7, at 7:15 a.m. when Leno called him to inform. Kenny will speak with all the maintenance team to make sure they notify him of any fire related emergency, regardless how big or small.

What we have done related to Customer Service and helping the resident, if anything?

Kenny contacted Granahan in the morning. Granahan replaced both outlets and the cover plate. Kenny also instructed them to make sure there was not damage to the wires in the wall. Job has been completed.
