#### **Description of Incident**

12/6/2021 Approximately around 8:30am a shooting occurred on the 7400 block of Calvert Street. A visitor to the resident of R201 Dominique Hill-Whitehead was leaving the apartment and got into his vehicle that was parked on the block on 7400 Calvert street. Another vehicle approached the visitor of R201's vehicle and began shooting at R201's visitor. Residents contacted 911. Police and paramedics arrived, and the police relayed the visitor of R201 had been shot at least 11 times and there were 57 shots fired. Detectives believe the shooters were waiting for the visitor of R201 to come out and get into the vehicle. The visitor of R201 was taken to the hospital and was in critical condition. Police closed the street, gathered evidence, and reopened the street in the early afternoon after the vehicle was towed. The detective provided his contact information Lieutenant Rosenbaum 215-685-3153 and DC# 21-020-528-64 During the shooting, three bullets hit the balcony door of D201 and broke the glass and entered the wall. Nilsa Reyes contacted Ms. Leal resident of D201 to make sure they were ok and to arrange for maintenance.

## Corrective action taken at the time of the incident

Police were contacted and arrived with paramedics. Nancy Benner contacted John Samuel and relayed there was shooting on Calvert street involving a resident's guest. Nancy Benner and Dudlow Blake spoke with Lieutenant Rosenbaum, and he provided what information he could and the DC#. John Samuel and Dudlow Blake visited D201 and made sure to do the necessary repairs. R201 was placed on non renewal

# What we have done related to Customer Service and helping the resident, if anything?

Nilsa Reyes contacted the residents of D201 they were very pleasant and understanding and relayed they were all ok and thanked us for calling. John Samuel drafted correspondence to go out to the residents, which was send out around 6pm. We replaced broken patio door at D201 and cleaned up the area.
