As a law enforcement officer I attend annual mandatory training as required by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to maintain my certification. This training includes current updates to Pennsylvania law including current case law pertaining to search and seizure. I have also received training from the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF&E); the El Paso Information Center (EPIC); National White Collar Crime Center; Middle Atlantic-Great Lakes Organized Crime Law Enforcement Network (MAGLOCLLEN); Public Agency Training Council; New Mexico Tech; Montgomery County Department of Public Safety; Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention; Delaware County Community College, Montgomery County School of Criminal Investigation; Live Digital Evidence: Social Networking, Linux & Network Seizure; Cell Phone Technology; DNA Evidence: First Responding Officers; DNA Evidence: Investigators and Evidence Technicians; Cell Phone Mapping and Analysis; Social Media & Technical Skills; Cellebrite Certified Operator and Cellebrite Certified Physical Analyst.

Probable Cause

On August 19, 2020 at approximately 0400 hours officers from the Cheltenham Township Police Department were summoned to Jeans Hospital for a report of a woman who had been the victim of a rape. The victim, whose identity is known to police, but will be referred to as K.E., stated to Officer Stocklos #1038 that she had been raped inside her apartment located at 8460 Limekiln Pike. This address is located within the boundaries of Cheltenham Township. The victim was transferred to Abington Memorial Hospital and treated by a SANE Nurse.

Your affiant interviewed K.E. at the Cheltenham Township Police Department. The victim told me that she was alone in her apartment when, sometime between 2330 hours on August 18, 2020 and 0000 hours on August 19, 2020, a male she believed was maintenance for the Towers at Wyncote knocked on her door requesting to enter so he could check for a water leak. According to the victim, this is the fourth time since May of this year that this male entered her apartment after 10PM to check for an alleged water leak; a leak has never been found. Prior to this male's arrival the victim stated that she had two drinks between 2030 and him knocking on the door. When the male entered he checked for a leak and when he didn't find one he asked K.E. if he could have a drink. K.E. went on to say that, because she had dealt with this male a few times in the past few months, she agreed to have a drink with him. During their conversation the suspect told her that he was the father of her neighbor's baby and that he has heard K.E. having sex with her boyfriend, and it turns him on. It was later determined that the neighboring apartment that the suspect was referring to is #1015.

K.E. went on to tell me that the male suspect then began pulling off her clothes and forcing himself onto her as she told him “no” several times and tried to push him off. The male suspect then got on top of her, held her down and forced his penis into her vagina as she continued to say “no” and attempt to push him off, but was unsuccessful.

Based on my experiences with the Towers at Wyncote Apartment Complex all visitors have to sign the electronic visitor log and inform the concierge of what apartment they are going to. This information, along with the tenant information for apartment #1015 can be accessed by the Leasing/Management Office.

Based on this Affidavit of Probable Cause I respectfully request that a search warrant be granted for the information detailed on the Application for Search Warrant and Authorization Page that is included with this document.

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PROBABLE CAUSE BELIEF IS BASED UOPN THE FOLLOWING FACTS AND CIRCUMSTANCES:

Training and Experience of Detective Matthew Gonglik #1023

Your affiant, Detective Matthew Gonglik, is a law enforcement officer employed with the Cheltenham Township Police Department who is currently assigned to the Detective Division.

I started my law enforcement career in August of 2002 when I accepted a position of Police Officer with the Philadelphia Police Department. After successfully graduating the Philadelphia Police Academy I was assigned to the 23rd District where I was first assigned to the Patrol Division. I was subsequently assigned to the 23rd District's "5 Squad" who work under the direction of the Captain. As a member of the "5 Squad" I was assigned to handle uniformed tasks that ranged from quality of life arrests to plain clothes assignments to combat open air narcotic sales, burglary, robbery, theft, firearm violations as well as other violent crimes. During my time as a Philadelphia Police Officer I made or was involved in numerous arrests related to the aforementioned crimes.

In January of 2008 I accepted a position of Police Officer with the Cheltenham Township Police Department and upon my completion of their 6 week Field Training Program; I was assigned to the Patrol Division. While assigned to the Patrol Division I handled such assignments as traffic enforcement, citizen complaints and I was also involved in or made arrests for numerous violations of the Pennsylvania Crimes Code. In January of 2014 I was selected to become part of the Cheltenham Township Police Department's Detective Division. As a detective I have investigated and assisted in investigations involving such crimes as Murder, Rape, Robbery, Burglary, Aggravated Assault as well as numerous other violations of the Pennsylvania Crimes Code. As a part of these investigations I have authored and executed numerous search warrants and court orders to located evidence in vehicles, physical addresses, cellular telephones, cellular account records, Sony and Microsoft gaming accounts, Internet Service Provider (ISP) accounts, DNA samples along with other search warrants pertinent to these investigations. I have also authored and executed arrest warrants and have spoken with and conducted formal interviews with witnesses, victims and suspects during my investigations.
