Two of the boys she was with were walking down the hallway, banging on residents doors then they all ran away. We were able to view the incident by brining up the camera footage. We cannot identify that any of the other people are residents, only Zuri. We have received calls from the residents this happened to and they were very scared. If Zuri is going to have guests at her home, they need to be inside the apartment, not in the hallway.

In addition to your responsibility for following all Lease rules, it is important to remember that you are also responsible for the action of other occupants of your unit, including children, and guests.
