## Summary:

## Largest Variances:

- Income (\$4K) due to (\$5.4k) in vacancy, and (\$4.5k) in allowance for doubtful accounts. Offset by +\$3k in ELT fees and +\$2.3k in GPR
- Utilities (\$3.1k) due to gas expense and income (will review further-unfavorable YTD on expense)
- Payroll +\$1.2K due to small favorable variances in each category
- Supplies +\$1.7K due to lower need for supplies.
- Repairs (\$4.3K) Due to (\$3.1K) in building contractor (storage cleanout and light pole damage in parking lot), (\$1.3k) in Landscaping contractor (timing of invoices-April paid in March), and (\$1.2k) in trash due to extra pick ups for storage cleanout. Offset by +\$2.1k due to no snow
- Make Readies (\$10.8K) due 4 additional make readys completed and timing of Feb. MR invoices (total of 13 MRs for Feb. & March)
- G&A +\$1.9K due to timing of legal and license invoices

Current occupancy 90.66% vs 92.99% last year

Move outs scheduled for May (2), June (4) and July (2)

May occupancy projection 92%

Focus is on improving occupancy and trend. Pricing adjustments have been made, email blasts sent, continued vacant unit inspections, etc. Capital -

Installation of Apt. Fire horns are still in progress and the estimated completion w/o 5/31/24.

Awaiting a start date for transformer delivery and installation

The fences for trash area and propane tanks approved and being scheduled for installation.
