Summary:

Largest Variances

- Income +\$6.6k due to +\$8.6k in vacancy and +\$1.9k in bad debt due to timing. Offset by (\$3.2k) in ELT fees
- Utilities (\$8k) due to unfavorable electric expense due to timing and unfavorable gas income/expense-Stephen working on plan with Banyan to recoup resident underbilling YTD
- Payroll (\$6.4k) due to timing of temp expense for open leasing/maintenance position-both now filled, Clester Bruce PTO payout at retirement, and bonuses
- Supplies (\$11.4k) due to pre season purchase of A/Cs before tarrifs-Ketty and Alison discussed budget and need to order within budgeted amount
- REpairs +\$4k due to +\$6k for timing of 1st landscaping invoice, and +\$2.6k due to budgeted for change of cleaning contractor not yet implemented. Offset by (\$5.4k) for timing of snow removal invoices (in line YTD) and (\$2.2k) for roof repairs needed
- Make Ready +\$3.2k due to 1 less completed and timing of invoices received
- G&A (\$4.7k) due to timing of Zillow pay per lead invoices and timing of software expense, as well as new software such as Renew Current occupancy 97.81% vs same time last year 96.83%
